To ensure the safest and most reliable environment for >all of our dogs, Peace Love Dogs INC requires the following items be in place for your dog before he or she will be granted access:

- Must be spayed or neutered if over the age of 12 months unless otherwise approved.
- Must be up to date on all vaccinations: Bordetella (every 6 months), Rabies (1 or 3 year) and DHPP (1 or 3 year)
- Completed and signed Peace Love Petcare release forms>
- Our prospective guests must participate in a behavioral assessment test, free of charge, to ensure that potential dogs are suitable for daycare and/or overnight stays.
- PLPC reserves the right to turn away any dog who exhibits behavior unsuitable for a daycare and/or overnight environment.
- If your dog(s) exhibit any behavior(s) that would lead us to feel they are unfit for this environment, we can recommend training programs to teach positive, relaxed, social behavior. Once your dog(s) have completed the good behavior classes, they will be eligible for a second chance at being assessed to participate in daycare and/or overnight uses.

I agree to the company Policies and Procedures as well as the following relative to my dog's care at Peace Love Dogs Inc (PLPC).

PLPC will keep the premises in sanitary condition and provide properly enclosed areas and exercise reasonable care for the safety of your dog. All overnight dogs will be housed in safe, clean quarters. All dogs will be fed properly and regularly. PLPC cannot be liable for damage or loss by or to dogs at this facility and/ or under the care of PLPC.

Owner understands that the concept of dog daycare, group play, and overnight boarding is to allow dogs to socially interact with both humans and dogs. Dogs in group play participate in supervised activities such as fetch, jumping, playing with toys; there is always a possibility of injury resulting from rough play between dogs. The owner agrees that any injury to their dog during their use of the facility and/ or under the care of PLPC shall not be cause for any liability of any type on the part of PLPC.

Owner agrees not to bring their pet into our facility if the dog is showing any signs of being sick, has fleas, active canine papilloma virus, or that its behavior may jeopardize the safety and health of other pets and/or our staff.

Abandonment shall automatically relinquish all rights and claims by the owner to the animal. Abandonment is determined to be the refusal to provide or perform the legal obligations for care of the animal by its owner or agent.

PLPC is authorized by the owner to seek veterinary care, including emergency care, at the owner's expense. If time permits, PLPC will try and contact you, the owner, before obtaining any care; however, this form serves as the

authorization PLPC needs to obtain veterinary care for your dog regardless. The owner is responsible for veterinarian expenses and transportation, whether or not the owner was reached in advance.

The owner agrees to pay all charges for daycare and boarding before picking up their pet. Your pet will not be released until all charges are paid in full.

The owner covenants not to initiate any legal proceedings of any sort against PLPC as a result of illness, injury, damage or death to owner's dog while under the care of PLPC and agrees that, should the owner bring a legal action against PLPC, the correct result of such a legal action should be a summary dismissal in favor of PLPC and the owner will also agree to pay PLPC costs, including, but not limited to attorney's fees.

The owner agrees that in the rare and unfortunate event, if your pet dies in our care your pet will be taken to your designated veterinarian and maintained for pick-up or further instruction.

The owner agrees that by signing the Care and Authorization form one time that it remains in full effect and force >each and every time the owner brings the owner's dog or dogs to PLPC for any of our services.

Please cancel bookings as soon as possible. Cancellations and No-Shows that take place less than 48 hours of the scheduled date will be charged the full amount of their scheduled stay. Holiday bookings are also non-refundable and in addition, will require a 50% deposit due at time of booking. Please be mindful, as we have limited space because we are caring for fewer dogs in order to give your dog the attention and love he or she deserves.

I understand that there may be live video feed of my dog at play which will be available to the public, online through the PLPC website. I agree to allow PLPC, it's owners, employees, officers, directors, and agents to use my dog's name and any images or likeness of my dog taken while he/she is in the custody and care of PLPC, in any form or format, for use, at any time, in any media, marketing, advertising, illustration, trade or promotional materials.

PLPC will not administer tranquilizers, sedatives or any other pharmaceutical drug designed to calm an animal unless the drug is administered under the direction of the animal's veterinarian, with a written prescription from the animal veterinarian, and with written permission from the animal's owner. Expired medication will not be administered to pets under any circumstance and will be discarded.

Owner authorizes their veterinarian to release all information regarding the status of vaccinations and fecal exams for pets. The vaccinations that are required by PLPC are DHLPP, RABIES and BORDETELLA.

I HAVE READ, UNDERSTAND, AND AGREE TO ALL THE PROVISIONS OF THIS AUTHORIZATION. I fully intend to pick up my dog on the specified date at the specified time. I will notify Peace Love Petcare of any changes to the >pick up date/time and assume full responsibility for any additional charges. I hereby agrees to waive any and all claims against PLPC and release PLPC and their employees from any right that I may have in law to recover medical payments, bodily injury damages, or property damages for any liability regardless of the cost, as a result of any injury resulting from the actions of my dog, any other dog, or any humans. I hereby agree to the pet care authorization form as the owner of the dog(s). I also certify that my dog(s) is/are in good health and do not show any signs of illness that may be contagious. Furthermore, I certify that all the information provided about my dog is accurate to the best of my knowledge. I have read, understand, and agree to all the provisions of this form.
